

Devoted supporters of German wine follow vintage news from the Rheingau and Mosel region just as closely as others do with regard to Bordeaux, the Rhone and the Douro. In our Festival from famed winemaker Ulrich Allendorf we are delighted to share this super crisp, dry Riesling from the Rheingau that punctuates your glass with citrus peel and elegant floral notes. And better yet, this wine is contained in an unbreakable, one-of-a-kind, 1 Liter bottle. Easily transportable, the bottle goes anywhere from picnics and yachting to camping and backyard cookouts. The Festival Riesling has a clear, pale straw color with just a hint of gold. Its fresh flavors speak of ripe peaches and pear. The fresh fruit is nicely shaped by crisp but not overwhelming acidity and a lightweight 10.5% alcohol.

The Rheingau has had a long tradition of growing Riesling. In fact, 20% of the Riesling grapes now grown in Germany are grown in this area making the Rheingau the number one producer of Riesling wine in Germany. Riesling is a slow growing grape, a fact which helps the resulting wines display the unique fruit-acid structure. The Rheingau region, although located in a northern wine producing area of Germany, is best positioned to take advantage of the late autumn sun.

This is a fantastic benchmark Riesling great when serving your family, friends and best of all share with the ones you love during the Holidays.
